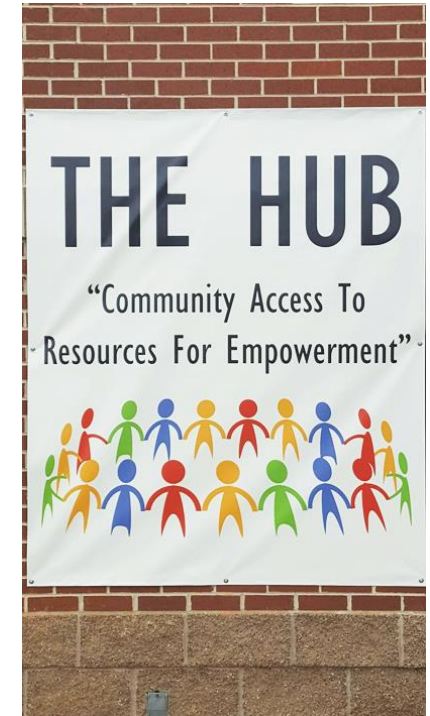

The HUB is a community center serving families of school aged children who attend Wheat Ridge area schools.

What are the eligibility requirements?

All families who are in need in the Wheat Ridge articulation, and have a school aged child (ages 3 to 21), are eligible for services.

Students of families must attend one of the 10 Wheat Ridge area schools, or live in the Wheat Ridge area and attend a charter, option, or other Jeffco school program. Families of students who are taking the GED or being re-engaged in school are also eligible.

Families must present an ID, or another form of identification. If you do not have an ID, or your Wheat Ridge student does not have an ID please contact Anna Jackson at 303-982-2198.
